PEDESTRIAN ACCESS and MOBILITY PLAN (PAMP) FOR THE GLADESVILLE TOWN CENTRE

Do you live, work, shop or walk around Gladesville?

The City of Ryde and Hunters Hill Councils are developing a Pedestrian Access and Mobility Plan (PAMP) for the Gladesville Town Centre and surrounding area.

The key aims of the PAMP are to:

- Make the area safer and easier to walk around
- Develop a continuous and comprehensive network of footpaths and other pedestrian infrastructure such as crossings and kerbs
- Develop a staged action plan and schedule of works for any infrastructure that will need to be replaced, upgraded or constructed.

We need your feedback to understand the key issues and concerns for pedestrians in the Gladesville Town Centre. The consultation period will run until Friday 13 December 2013.
